I assume full responsibility for my child’s mental and physical well-being and any and all medical costs resulting from participation on this team and program through my insurance provider or my own resources. I understand that my child’s registration is non-transferable to another player or season. I understand that if my child no longer wishes to participate in the Saints Lacrosse Club that all paid fees are forfeited and that all team equipment must be returned immediately. I am financially responsible for the team equipment supplied to me for any excessive damages (excluding normal wear and tear) or lost/stolen equipment.
